## Saturday May 1 Low Net by Flights

This Event is a Low Net Event by Flight. Net Scores are calculated by subtracting your course handicap from your actual Score.

New members who do not have a handicap will have a handicap calculated using the Callaway Handicap System and will be slotted in Flights based on the calculated handicap.

## Saturday May 8 Match Play vs Par

This Event is a Match Play vs Par by Flight.

This is an individual match play event, by flights. Using your course handicap, the individual will match their hole-by-hole score against par.

The player that wins the most holes compared to holes lost is the winner.

New members who do not have a handicap will have a handicap calculated using the Callaway Handicap System and will be slotted in Flights based on the calculated handicap.

## Saturday May 29/Sunday May 30 2 Man Best Ball by Flights

- This event is a 2 Day 2-Man Best Ball by Flight Event (Four-Ball).
- The Team Score on each hole is the Best Net Score of the Team.
- 4 Flights will be used for this event.
- 90% of a player's course handicap will be used for this event.
- Tee Times for Sunday will be assigned based on Saturday's results. Flights will play in same time range.
- Flights will be grouped with Leaders playing in the last groups.

## Saturday June 5 4 Man Team (Red/White/Blue)

- This Event is a 4 Man team Event.
- On 6 holes players will hit from the red tees
  - Players will count all 4 net scores on these 6 holes.
- On 6 holes, players will hit from the white tees
  - Players will count best 3 net scores on these 6 holes.
- On 6 holes, players will hit from the blue tees
  - Players will count best 2 scores on these 6 holes.

## Sunday June 13 2 Man Team (Multiplier)

This is a 2- person team event by flights. The net balls of both team members will count on each hole. To determine the teams score for a hole you **multiply** the net score of Player "A" times the net score of Player "B".

Example:  
Hole #1 Player A scores a net 4 while his playing partner scores a net 6. The team score on that hole is 24 (4x6=24)

### **Saturday June 26/Sunday June 27 Match Play/Low Net**

This Event is a Match Play/Low Net Event

**All Matches are 9 Hole matches**

**Saturday First Nine**

1<sup>st</sup> Player vs 2<sup>nd</sup> player on scorecard.

3<sup>rd</sup> Player vs 4<sup>th</sup> player on scorecard.

**Winners** on 1<sup>st</sup> nine on Saturday play each other and are in **Winners bracket**.

**Losers** on 1<sup>st</sup> nine on Saturday play each other and are in the **Consolation bracket**.

If you lose your 2<sup>nd</sup> match on Saturday you are entered in Low net for Sunday.

On Sunday, if you are in the consolation bracket, all players are in the Low Net event except for the Consolation winner. The loser of the 3<sup>rd</sup> place match in a flight is also in the Low net event.

### **Saturday July 10 2 Man Stableford**

This Event is a 2-Man Team Stableford Event.

Points are scored based on both players net score on each hole

• Points are calculated as follows:

• Net Double Bogie or Greater	-3
• Net Bogie	-1
• Net Par	0
• Net Birdie	+2
• Net Eagle	+5
• Net Double Eagle	+8

The team with the most points is the winner.

### **Saturday July 24/Sunday July 25 Sundance Classic**

- This Event is a 5-Man Team Event Using the Quota System.
- Points are awarded to each player based on their actual (gross) score on a hole.
- Each Player is given a Quota which is calculated by subtracting a player's handicap from 36.
- The minimum quota for a player is 4 points per day
  - (Only pertains to those players who have a handicap of over 32)
- The player with worst results to quota on each nine holes will not count towards team score.
- Points Calculation
 

• Bogie	1 Point
• Par	2 Points
• Birdie	3 Points
• Eagle	4 Points
• Double Eagle	5 Points

### **Tournament Qualifications Sundance Classic**

- **Sundance Classic (July 24/25)**
- A member must play a minimum of six (6) **registered rounds of golf** at Sundance Golf Course in 2010 and a member must have played and completed a minimum of **two (2) Men's Club Events** to qualify for the Classic.
- For the 2010 season these qualifications must be met by **July 11, 2010** (Two weeks before the tournament).
- **The Classic sign up deadline is Sunday, July 11, 2010**

### **Sunday August 8 4 Man Team (Scrumble)**

- This Event is a 4 Man team Event.
- On each hole all players hit their drives
- The team will select a drive and all players will then play their own ball into the hole from the place of that drive.
- All net scores for players will count on each hole, strokes will be given as they fall based on your handicap.
- The team with the best results will be the winner.
- Tee times will start at 11:00 am timeframe for this tournament rather than at 7:00 am.

### **Saturday August 28/Sunday August 29 Club Championship**

This tournament is the Club Championship of the Sundance Men's Club.

The following events are featured in this Tournament.

- 1.) Low Net by Flights - Trophy for 1st Place
- 2.) Low Gross Overall - Trophy for 1st Place
- 3.) Low Gross Senior (Must be 55 by Aug 28, 2010 and not qualify for Super Senior.) - Trophy for 1st Place
- 4.) Low Gross Super Senior (Must be 65 by Aug 28, 2010) - Trophy for 1st Place

Trophies will be awarded at Fall Banquet for Flight winners/ Club Champion/Senior Club Champion/Super Senior Club Champion.

## Tournament Qualifications Club Championship

- **Sundance Club Championship (August 28/29).**
- A member must have played a minimum of ten **(10) registered rounds of golf** at Sundance Golf Course in 2010 and a member must have played and completed a minimum of **three (3) 2010 Men's Club Events to qualify for the Club Championship.**
- For the 2010 season, these qualifications must be met by **August 15, 2010** (Two weeks before the Tournament).
- **The Club Championship sign-up deadline is Sunday, August 15, 2010**

## Saturday September 11 2 Man Team (Combination)

This event is a 2-man Team event playing three (3) different formats.

### **Holes 1-6 Scramble**

Each 2-man team hits a tee ball and then will select their best ball to hit the 2<sup>nd</sup> shot.

The teams 3<sup>rd</sup> best shot will then be selected and each will hit from that spot, and so on until the team holes their putt. .

### **Holes 7 – 12 Alternate Shot**

Each 2-man team hits a tee ball and then will select their best ball to hit the 2<sup>nd</sup> shot.

The player whose ball was selected shall not hit the next shot, his partner will hit the 2<sup>nd</sup> shot.

The alternate partner will then hit the 3<sup>rd</sup> shot and players will continue to take turns in a similar fashion until the ball is holed..

### **Holes 13-18 Best Ball**

Each member of the 2-man team will play their own ball for the entire hole.

After the hole the team members will record their best ball for that hole.

## Saturday Sept 25/Sunday Sept 26 Points Championship

- This tournament is open to the top 100 members in the points standing for the year and anyone who played in a minimum of 8 Men's Club events if they don't qualify in the top 100 for points.
- This event is a 2-day event where the best net score for a player for each hole for the 2 days will be used as player's score for the event. (2-day Ringer Tournament)
- Earn points three ways
  - Attend Men's Club Meetings (2 points each)
    - Spring, Classic, Club Championship
  - Play Men's Club Events, points are awarded for playing in a tournament and also awarded to top finishers in Tournaments.
  - Play MPGA Tournaments (2 points each)

## Membership Obligation

- The Sundance Men's Club By laws state the following in regard to membership obligations.
- Each member shall during a season, play a minimum of **Fourteen (14) registered 18-hole rounds of golf at Sundance Golf Course.**
- Each member must play in at least **3 Men's Club Events.**
- Men's Club Tournament rounds played count toward the 14 round obligation.
- The 14 round obligation and 3 round event obligation must be met by **October 15, 2010.**

## Event Sign-Up Information

- Sign-up sheets for the next 3 Sundance Men's Club Events will be posted in the Pro Shop.
- Place your signature/initials in the blocks provided for each Event.
- Sign up for early times by placing an "E" next to your initials or sign up for a late time by placing an "L" next to your initials. **Early and Late sign-ups will be limited.**
- Sign-up is also available via our web site [www.sundancemensclub.com](http://www.sundancemensclub.com), follow instructions on web page, sign-up submits an email to Claire Deering.

## Event/Cancellation

- **If you sign up for an Event and cannot play...**
  - Please call **Tournament Chairman Claire Deering** at **(763) 560-0501 (home phone) or at (763) 639-0501 (cell phone)** as early as possible to cancel out of the Event.
  - **Do not call the Pro Shop to cancel unless it is the day of the event.**

### No-Show/Pick-up during event

- If a player signs up for an event and does not show-up for tee time or walks off course, except for physical or emergency reasons, the following will apply:
- **Minimum penalty-suspension for next 2 events**
- **This includes players who sign-up for a 2-day event and do not show up on 2<sup>nd</sup> day.**

### Hole-in-one Event

- The Hole-in-one event began on **Saturday April 3, 2010 and ends on Saturday October 2, 2010.**
- A Hole-in-one must be witnessed by another Sundance Men's Club Member and must be scored during a 9 or 18 hole stipulated round of golf played at Sundance Golf Course.
- The hole in one **must be scored on a weekend or Holiday** to qualify for the Men's' Club Prize money reserved for holes in ones.
- All members are entered in the hole-in-one prize money, it is part of membership dues.

### Posting Scores

- **It is each member's responsibility to make sure score cards are posted for all rounds of golf played** (Do not assume someone else will post your score).
- Handicap Computer is **in back of the Pro Shop.**

### Posting a Tournament Score

- **MEN'S CLUB EVENT SCORES WILL BE POSTED BY MYSELF OR DAVE...**
  - Turn in score card to the pro shop after tournament rounds.
- Sundance Men's Club Members should **post Men's Club Events, 16 Man team Events, Senior 8-Man team Events, MPGA Events, MGA Events** and other forms of competitions as Tournament Rounds.
- Score cards should be adjusted for equitable stroke before they are posted on the computer for handicap purposes.

### Handicap Review

- **Equitable Stroke Control (ESC)** sets a maximum number that a player can post on any hole depending on the player's Course Handicap. ESC is used only when a player's actual or most likely score exceeds his maximum number based on the table below.

Course Handicap	Maximum Number On Any Hole
9 or less	Double Bogey*
10 through 19	7
20 through 29	8
30 through 39	9
40 or more	10

### New Members/Handicap

- To establish a Handicap for the Sundance Men's Club, a new member must play a minimum of **five (5) rounds of golf at Sundance Golf Course.**
- A new member may **play in the first 2 Individual Events of the year without a handicap.**
- New members who do not have a Handicap for the first 2 events of the year will have their Handicap calculated using the **Callaway Handicap System** and will be slotted by Flights based on the calculated Callaway handicap.
- **All other events require a handicap.**

### Posting scores in inactive season

- Scores made at any golf course observing an **inactive season** are not acceptable for handicap purposes.
- Scores made at a golf course in an area observing an **active season** must be posted for handicap purposes, even if the **golf club** from which the player receives a **Handicap Index** is observing an **inactive season.**
- The club's **Handicap Committee** must make it possible for a player to post these away scores prior to the next **Handicap Index** revision. If possible, the club must re-compute the player's **Handicap Index** at that start of the **active season.**

Other MPGA information is available for the MPGA web site such as Championship results/24-man/16-man team/8-man team schedules, rules of play, pace of play.

### MPGA Tournament Requirements

- Except for the Junior Public Links, MPGA Tournaments requirements are as follows:
- **ELIGIBILITY:** Amateur players who are members of a men's club that is a member of the Minnesota Public Golf Association and players must carry an active GHIN handicap.
- Sundance is a member of the MPGA and all Sundance men's Club members are eligible to participate in MPGA Tournaments.

### Mid-Amateur/Individual Low Net May 15/16

- **Course:** Emerald Greens - Hastings
- **FORMAT:** The **Individual Low Net Championship** is a two-day, 36-hole event. This event will have divisions based on the number of entries and handicaps of players. Competition is net stroke play.  
**MID-AM:** The **State Mid-Amateur Championship** is a two-day, 36-hole event. This event will be one division stroke play (no handicap). Players must be 30 years of age or older.
- **Entry Deadline:** May 1
- **Cost:** \$65.00 per player

### Four-Ball June 19/20

- **Course:** Monticello Country Club - Monticello
- **FORMAT:** This championship will be divided into four flights. The Championship Flight will play with no handicap and is elective.
- The remaining entries will be split as equally as possible using a ranking of combined handicaps into three flights. Each team member will play with 90% of his Monticello course handicap.
- Tournament is played under Four-Ball Stroke Play Rules.
- **Entry Deadline:** June 5
- **Cost:** \$120.00 per team

### Senior Public Links/Low Net July 17/18

- **Course:** Highland National – St Paul
- **ELIGIBILITY:** Players must be at least 50 years of age as of July 17, 2010.
- **FORMAT:** The Tournament will be divided into four divisions. The Championship Division (#1) will be elective and played at stroke play, no handicap (gross). The remaining three divisions will be established based upon the player's handicap index and competition will be at net stroke play.
- **Entry Deadline:** July 2
- **Cost:** \$65.00 per player

### Junior Public Links July 20

- **Course:** Highland National – St Paul
- **ELIGIBILITY:** This tournament is open to all male junior amateur players, ages 13 to 18, on July 20, 2010, who are affiliated with or play substantially all of their golf at a public golf course.
- **FORMAT:** This event is an 18-hole stroke play event. There will be multiple divisions based on age. Prizes will be given to the low 18-hole scores in each age division. The low 12 players and ties regardless of division will play an additional 9 holes. The Junior Public Links Champion will be the player with the lowest 27-hole score regardless of age division.
- **Entry Deadline:** July 7
- **Cost:** \$20.00 per player – includes snack after round.

### Public Links Championship August 21-22

- **Course:** The Jewel – Lake City
- **ELIGIBILITY:** Players must have a GHIN handicap index of 5.5 or less at the time of entry to be eligible to compete.
- **FORMAT:** The tournament will be a two-day, 36-hole event for all entered players (no cut). **Threesome pairings will be used for this Championship.**
- **ENTRY:** Entries will be limited to the first 90 received.
- **Entry Deadline:** August 7
- **Entry Fee:** \$90.00 per player

### Combination September 18-19

- **Course:** Bunker Hills – Coon Rapids
- **FORMAT:** This tournament is a 27 hole, one day event. Each two-man team will play nine holes partner best ball, nine holes partner scramble (best shot), and nine holes partner alternate shot.
- Up to six divisions will be determined based on the number of entries received and team's combined handicap index. Divisions I, II and III will play on Saturday, Sept. 18th. Divisions IV, V and VI will play on Sunday, Sept. 19th. Teams will play within their divisions with no handicap. The partner's handicap indexes may not differ by more than 8.0 at time of entry.
- **Note:** In 2009 the cutoff between division-3 and division-4 was a combined handicap index of 13.7.
- **Entry Deadline:** September 4
- **Cost:** \$120.00 per team

- The top teams from each class will advance to playoffs
- Semi-final-September 12(Neutral Site)
- Final- September 26. (Neutral Site)
